With reference to the Deep Panuke Roseate Tern Monitoring Program submitted to the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board on April 14, 2008, please note that the Deep Panuke landfall preparation program is expected to begin near Goldboro, NS in November 2008 instead of September 2008 as mentioned in our April 14, 2008, letter. Based on this revised start date for the program, the Roseate terns will have migrated out of the area and there is no need for specific tern monitoring during the landfall preparation activities (Becky Whittam, BSC, pers. comm.).

While the program is anticipated to be approximately four months in duration, EnCana confirms that the landfall preparation program will be completed by no later than April 18, 2009, before the start of the local lobster fishing season, and also before the Roseate terns migrate back into the Country Harbour area.
