**Re: Cohasset Project Decommissioning – Follow-up Survey**

Completion of an ROV survey three years following the completion of the Cohasset Project decommissioning is a required follow-up measure of Condition 1 of the Development Plan Decision Report on the Application to Amend the Cohasset Development Plan. The condition is as follows:

*Condition 1: Screening Report Requirements Mitigation and Follow-up*

*The applicant shall comply with all requirements, mitigation, and follow-up measures identified in the Environmental Screening Report – Cohasset Phase II Decommissioning, as listed in Appendix 1 of this Decision Report.*

Requirement (b) of the Follow-up and Monitoring Requirements listed in Appendix 1 remains the only outstanding follow-up requirement. To satisfy Requirement B, the Board, in an August 31, 2005 teleconference, required EnCana's commitment to the following methodology:


*In addition to the proposed side scan sonar with a sub-bottom profiling apparatus, an ROV shall be used to gather visual data on any equipment that is observed to be uncovered. A digital dataset of the side scan sonar results shall be provided. An initial survey shall be completed within one year of abandonment, and an additional survey shall be completed in the third year after abandonment.*

The one year subsea survey was conducted November 28 to December 1, 2006.

A written description of the results of the survey were submitted to the Board on January 31, 2007.

This letter is a reminder that the Board is not yet in receipt of the results of the final survey. Please submit the results in due course.
