Beth, TC's Record of Determination is the same as the FCR Response completed and submitted to the CNSOPB on September 27, 2005 - TC is likely to require an EA of the project, pursuant to CEAA 5(1)(d) - NWPA 5(1)(a) for any proposed work within "the 12 mile limit" . Transport Canada's and hence NWPA's level of involvement will depend on the option selected by ENCANA.

As an option, the proponent may wish to apply for an NWPA authorization for both options in advance of final option selection to ensure facilitation of the NWPA authorization process and prevent any undue delays in the Federal Environmental Assessment Process.
