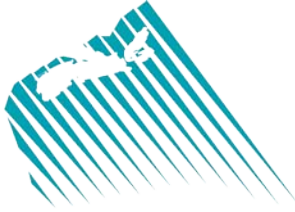

The Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board (CNSOPB) is located in Halifax, Nova Scotia, and is the independent joint agency of the Governments of Canada and Nova Scotia responsible for the regulation of petroleum activities in the Nova Scotia Offshore Area.

Advisor, Health and Safety

Reporting to the Director, Operations/ Health, Safety & Environment (HS&E), the Advisor, Health & Safety will be part of a team responsible for the interpretation, monitoring, and enforcement of HS&E regulatory requirements pertaining to offshore oil and gas activities.

The responsibilities include:

- Lead the HS&E audit and inspection process
- Conduct incident/accident/worker complaint investigations that occur on offshore installations or vessels
- Provide advice on marine safety and marine security
- Monitor daily offshore operations related to exploration and production of petroleum
- Participate in a on-call rotation schedule
- Upon Completion of an orientation period and Board appointment, perform the duties of Safety Officer

The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- University Degree, Post Secondary Technical Diploma, or equivalent work experience and education
- 7-10 years direct health and safety experience in offshore exploration and production activities preferred, with experience in marine safety matters
- Registration as a Canadian Registered Safety Professional (CRSP)
- Marine Industry Certification would be consider an asset
- Certified Lead Auditor by a recognized certification body would be consider an asset
- Must be able to complete the Basic Survival Training Course for frequent offshore travel
- Strong organizational skills including attention to detail and accuracy
- Ability to handle highly sensitive and confidential information
