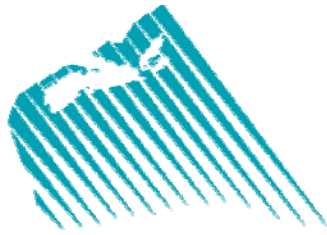

CANADA-NOVA SCOTIA OFFSHORE PETROLEUM BOARD

The Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board (CNSOPB) is the independent joint agency of the Governments of Canada and Nova Scotia responsible for the regulation of petroleum operations and safe work practices offshore Nova Scotia.

The Data Management Centre (DMC) is an online database designed to provide users with web access to non-confidential petroleum exploration and production data from offshore Nova Scotia. The DMC is housed in the CNSOPB's Geoscience Research Centre located in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

Data Management Centre Technician

This two year contract position is responsible for the day to day operation of DMC software.

Responsibilities include:

- Loading, checking and managing digital petroleum data, including offshore well data (logs & reports), Geographic Information Systems data and seismic trace and image data
- Operating and maintaining DMC software, including data management software, well and seismic databases
- Troubleshooting software issues
- Provide support/training to DMC clients and CNSOPB staff

Requirements include:

- Diploma/Certificate in Petroleum Technology or Diploma in Geographic Information Systems or Bachelor of Science (Earth Sciences) or equivalent degree/diploma with relevant IT experience
- Minimum 2 years of relevant experience
- Knowledge of Geological, Geophysical and Geographic Information Systems data, including the digital standards/data types commonly used
- Knowledge of Windows 2003 Server and LINUX Red Hat operating systems
- Knowledge of ARCIMS web technologies
- Ability to troubleshoot software issues
- Knowledge of petroleum database software and Oracle database management an asset
