

Board seeks comment on digital data policy

February 23, 2006

The Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board (CNSOPB, the Board) is currently considering a change to its policy on disclosure of offshore geological and geophysical data. The proposal is for digital well logs, reports and seismic traces to be released using current industry data standards such as, *LAS* for well logs, *PDF* for reports and *SEGY* for seismic trace data

The Board welcomes written comments on this policy revision, and will consider such comments prior to making a final decision on this issue at the May, 2006 Board Meeting.

All comments must be received before close of business on Friday, April 14th, 2006.
