


The Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board (CNSOPB) 24/7 Phone Line for Immediate Verbal Reporting:

Offshore employers and operators have reporting responsibilities for certain emergencies and events. Incidents and events which require 'immediate verbal notification' to the CNSOPB, as per legislative requirements and the 'Incident Reporting and Investigation Guidelines', may be reported using the phone number below.

It is also the legislated responsibility of each employee to first report health and safety concerns to their Supervisor. After following reporting processes in the workplace, if a situation is still unresolved, employees may notify a CNSOPB Officer via the number provided below.

What to expect when you call:

- Your call will be answered by a call-service dispatcher (*available 24/7, including holidays*)
- The dispatcher will take your name, phone number, and company
- The dispatcher will contact the assigned CNSOPB Duty Officer who will return your call and will be prepared to receive your report
