
This letter is with regard to the recent submission to you by Multiklient Invest ("MKI"), a Norwegian company, of a project description seeking to conduct seismic programs in Nova Scotia's offshore, including and/or near our precious fishing grounds.

It is most interesting that our provincial government convened an inquiry into the matter of fracking on land. However, no such inquiry has been held into the matter of exploring and drilling in our offshore. I would humbly suggest that such an inquiry is imperative given the fact that our fishery has an annual value of \$8 billion to the economy of Nova Scotia.

Therefore, I urge you to NOT proceed with this submission of MKI or any other party proposing to explore or drill offshore Nova Scotia until a proper public inquiry has been undertaken by our province into the matter of exploring and drilling in our offshore.
